Keyboard Shortcuts in Terminal on Mac



## Terminal Windows & Tab Keys

Keyboard Shortcut	Description
⌘ + N	New Window
⇧ + ⌘ + N	New Window with Same Command
⌘ + T	New Tab
⇧ + ⌘ + T	New Tab with Same Command
⇧ + ⌘ + T	Show Tab Bar   Hide Tab Bar
⇧ + ⌘ + V	Show All Tabs   Exit Tab Overview
⇧ + ⌘ + N	New Command
⇧ + ⌘ + K	New Remote Connection
⌘ + I	Show Inspector   Hide Inspector
⇧ + ⌘ + I	Edit Title
⌘ + I	Edit Background Colour
⌘ + 0	Default Font Size
⌘ + +	Make Fonts Bigger
⌘ + -	Make Fonts Smaller
⌘ + `	Cycle Through Windows
⌘ + ⇧ + ~	Cycle Through Windows (Reverse)
⌘ + ⇨	Show Next Tab
⌘ + ⇧ + ⇨	Show Previous Tab
⌘ + D	Split Panes
⇧ + ⌘ + D	Close Split Pane
⌘ + W	Close Tab
⇧ + ⌘ + W	Close Window
⌘ + ⌘ + W	Close Other Tabs
⌘ + ⇧ + ⌘ + W	Close All
⌘ + (fn + ←)	Scroll To Top
⌘ + (fn + →)	Scroll To Bottom
⌘ + (fn + ↑)	Page Up
⌘ + (fn + ↓)	Page Down
⌘ + ⌘ + (fn + ↑)	Line Up
⌘ + ⌘ + (fn + ↓)	Line Down

## Select & Find Text Keys

Keyboard Shortcut	Description
Click + Click + Click	Select a complete line of text.
Click + Click	Select a word
⇧ + ⌘ + Click + Click	Select a complete file path.
⇧ + ⌘ + Click + Click	Select a URL.
⌘ + Highlight	Select a rectangular block.
⌘ + X	Cut
⌘ + C	Copy
⌘ + ⇧ + ⌘ + C	Copy Without Background Colour
⌘ + ⇧ + ⌘ + C	Copy Plain Text
⌘ + V	Paste
⇧ + ⌘ + V	Paste The Selection
⌘ + ⌘ + V	Paste Escaped Text
⌘ + ⇧ + ⌘ + V	Paste Escaped Selection
⌘ + F	Find
⌘ + G	Find Next
⌘ + ⇧ + G	Find Previous
⌘ + E	Find using the Selected Text
⌘ + J	Jump to the Selected Text
⌘ + A	Select All
⌘ + ⌘ + ⌘	Open the Character Viewer

## Mark & Bookmark Keys

Keyboard Shortcut	Description
⌘ + U	Mark
⌘ + ⌘ + U	Mark as Bookmark
⇧ + ⌘ + U	Unmark
⌘ + ↵	Mark Line and Send Return
⇧ + ⌘ + ↵	Send Return without Marking
⇧ + ⌘ + M	Insert Bookmark
⌘ + ⌘ + M	Insert Bookmark with Name
⌘ + ↑	Jump to Previous Mark
⌘ + ↓	Jump to Next Mark
⌘ + ⌘ + ↑	Jump to Previous Bookmark
⌘ + ⌘ + ↓	Jump to Next Bookmark
⌘ + L	Clear to Previous Mark
⌘ + ⌘ + L	Clear to Previous Bookmark
⌘ + K	Clear to Start
⇧ + ⌘ + A	Select Between Marks

## Edit Command Line Keys

Keyboard Shortcut	Description
⌘ + Click	Reposition the insertion point.
⌘ + A	Move the insertion point to the beginning of the line.
⌘ + E	Move the insertion point to the end of the line.
→	Move the insertion point forwards one character.
←	Move the insertion point backwards one character.
⌘ + →	Move the insertion point forwards one word.
⌘ + ←	Move the insertion point backwards one word.
⌘ + U	Delete to the beginning of the line.
⌘ + K	Delete to the end of the line.
⌘ + D	Delete forwards to the end of the word.
⌘ + W	Delete backwards to the beginning of the word.
⌘	Delete one character to the left.
fn + ⌘	Delete one character to the right.
⌘ + T	Transpose two characters.

## Other Shortcut Keys

⌘ + ⌘ + F	Enter Full Screen   Exit Full Screen
⇧ + ⌘ + C	Show Colours   Hide Colours
⌘ + ,	Open Terminal Preferences
⌘ + P	Print
⌘ + ⌘ + R	Soft Reset Terminal Emulator State
⌘ + ⌘ + ⌘ + R	Hard Reset Terminal Emulator State
⌘ + Click + Click	Open a URL
⌘ + S	Export Text As
⇧ + ⌘ + S	Export Selected Text As
⌘ + R	Reverse Search Command History
⌘ + R	Toggle "Allow Mouse Reporting" Option
⌘ + ⌘ + V	Toggle "Use Option As Meta Key" Option
⇧ + ⌘ + ↓	Show Alternate Screen
⇧ + ⌘ + ↑	Hide Alternate Screen
